


Fuel Management

Right to Know Filing

Any New York City facility storing or handling hazardous materials is required to complete the annual New York City Community Right-to-Know Program (RTK) Tier II filing with the New York City Department of Environmental Protection and New York City Fire Department. These filings are due annually by March 1, and the process involves several steps that Walden can handle for you completely and efficiently. In addition to chemical plants and power generating stations, Walden also regularly performs RTK filing for auto dealerships and is member of GNYADA (Greater New York Auto Dealer Association). Failure to complete this process, or doing so incorrectly, can result in large fines. Walden will ensure that your RTK filing is completed and filed on time.
